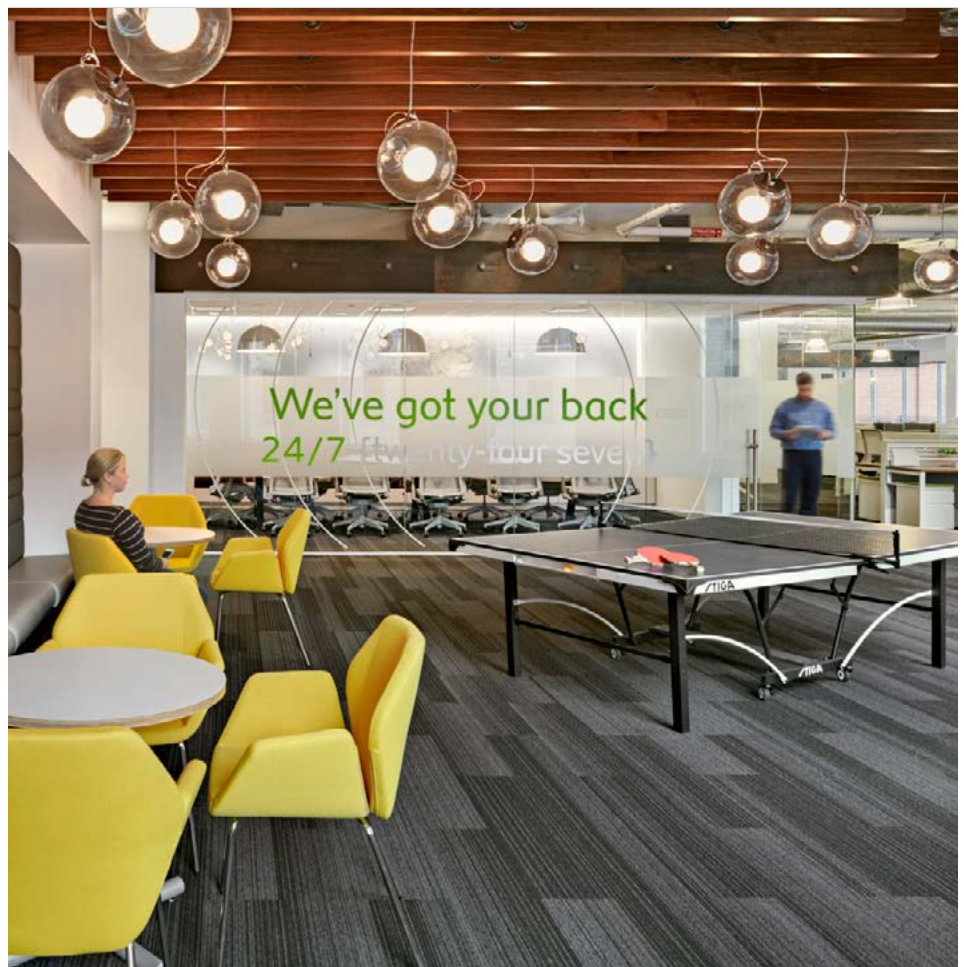
### Project Highlights

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Carbonite is an online back-up service that engaged IA for their headquarters relocation in Boston, MA. Under a tight budget and schedule, Carbonite wanted a new headquarters with a modern, sophisticated, vibrant, and fresh open office environment with ample collaboration space and top notch amenities to attract top talent.

The open office environment is strategically planned so that each department has their own neighborhood center. Each neighborhood provides employees with a variety of work settings from small focus rooms and traditional conference rooms, to more informal living rooms and touch down spaces. Within each living room, departmental identity is celebrated through unique finishes, lighting, and furniture.

Centrally located, free-flowing common amenities encourage cross-pollination among departments. Nestled off of the reception and main cafe is the "chill zone" where employees can challenge each other to a game of pool or conduct impromptu meetings. Within this zone, there is a transformable multi-purpose space that can divide into two or open up to the café for town hall meetings.
