

The design reflects a refreshing new approach to how the agency works and engages with clients. A family room atmosphere greets visitors with lounge seating, a ping pong table, beverage counters, and a kitchen with an above the sink window opening to a priceless view of iconic Pike Place Market, Elliot Bay, and the mountains beyond. All staff and executives sit in open desking systems to encourage communication and interaction. Circulation space does double duty as workspace and accommodates layout, filing, and work display. Original pivot windows and terrazzo floors celebrate the buildings historic past.
