

The IA design team transformed a typical high-rise office floor into a multi-purpose amenity center, which included converting a standard roof into a large and inviting rooftop deck equipped with a bar. This transformation required extensive coordination with the MEP, general contractor, and other consultants to meet the various code requirements of an assembly space, which differ from standard office space, and to quickly resolve any technical issues.

Areas of the center can be utilized separately or as one continuous event space. During regular business hours, for example, conference rooms are available for formal meetings and a lounge and rooftop deck for collaboration, individual focus work, and respite. For special meetings and events, the center can be combined into a single, unified space due to the flexibility of operable walls, glass pivot doors, and a folding glass curtain wall. Overall, the amenity center encourages social interaction, different forms of working, and provides the building with a centralized meeting place for tenants.
